

Exports, at record highs






The best year for Spanish exports

3% is the Spanish share of service exports



Wine


the first global wine exporter by volume and the third by value, according to data from the Spanish Market Observatory of Wine (OEMV).

the first global exporter with 170,383 tons, more than Italy, Tunisia, Turkey, and Greece, according to the Ministry of Agriculture, Fishing and Feeding from Spain.

Pork

the first exporter in Europe and the second in he world, according to Interporc.






Main destinations









Spanish economy abroad
